

Declaration of Consent

I hereby consent to the processing of my personal data to the extent and for the purposes set out below by the controller. The following conditions apply, which must be guaranteed pursuant to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) of the European Union.

1. Individuals

2. Purpose

My data will be processed exclusively for the following purposes:

attribution of digital files submitted to the “coronarchiv” platform, relevant inquiries from moderators by email in cases where the data are unclear.

3. Personal data

The following kinds of personal data and information will be collected and processed:

screen name, first name, surname, email address, place of residence, information about the uploaded files (optional).

4. Recipients/categories of recipients

My personal data will be transmitted to the following recipients: project team, moderators of the “coronarchiv” platform.

This serves the following purposes: attribution of submitted digital files, questions in cases where the data are unclear.

5. Period of storage

My personal data will be stored for the following period: 12 months.

They will be subsequently deleted or anonymized so they can no longer be linked to me personally.

6. My rights

I have the following rights:

a. Voluntariness

I cannot be forced or pressured to declare or maintain my consent.

b. Right of withdrawal

I may withdraw my consent at any time; effective as of the date of withdrawal. This may be done either verbally or via email. I may be required to provide proof of identification. Upon receipt of my withdrawal, my data may no longer continue to be processed and must be deleted immediately. This does not affect any previous processing of data and information.

c. Right to information

I have a right to information from the controller pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR.

7. Right to rectification

I may demand that the controller rectify any inaccurate data pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR.

a. Right to erasure (“right to be forgotten”)

I have the right to have my personal data and information deleted by the controller, “the right to be forgotten” pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR.

b. Restriction of processing

I have the right to restrict the processing of my personal data pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR.

c. Right to lodge a complaint

I have the right to lodge a complaint with the Hamburg Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (HmbBfDI) against the processing of my personal data.
